## Pre-Programme

### Context

At the 20<sup>th</sup> session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in December 2014 in Lima (COP20), the Executive Secretary of the UNFCCC and the Presidency of the COP21 were encouraged to convene a high-level event to enhance implementation of climate action.

Answering this call and building on the catalysing effect of the United Nations Secretary-General's Climate Summit of September 2014 and the work undertaken by Peru, France, the Executive Office of the United Nations Secretary-General and the UNFCCC, the Action Day highlights the existing momentum for scaled-up engagement by state and non-state actors and shows the necessity, feasibility and power of multi-stakeholder climate action.

Emblematic climate champions, panels, videos and artistic performances will be moderated by three journalists. Interpretation will be provided in the six United Nations official languages.
